Clark Rigging and Rental's regular customers don't worry about whether their job is too big, or even too small. They'll call Clark Rigging and Rental with a lift as heavy as a prefab unit for a commercial building or as light as roof rafters for a home. One thing that Clark's fifty-year-ride in the crane and rigging business has taught them, no matter what size the job, or how unusual, they've probably done it before.

For years, they've worked with the power industry on its construction projects. Major power companies don't like to take chances, and neither do any of Clark's customers. That's why when people need heavy objects moved, or need a crane, the first place they turn to is Clark Rigging and Rental.

Clark's projects include lifts and rigging for contractors, manufacturers, municipalities, and power companies. They're working right now on the new St. Lawrence County Jail in Canton, New York. The job demands work seven days a week and lifts on schedule. The jail cells come delivered as pre-made poured concrete, with the bed, toilet, and

sinks included in the unit...and they weigh 30 tons each. Clark's crew off loads the units rail-side onto a truck in Gouverneur, New York using their 200-Ton Demag crane. The units are then transported twenty miles to the construction site in Canton. There the crew uses their 300-Ton Demag crane to stack the units in place.

While the St. Lawrence County Jail demands heavy lifts, Clark has no problem with more specialized work. They recently finished a job installing an overhead crane inside the plant at Gibraltar Steel. One of the things about installing heavy equipment inside a manufacturing plant is the difficulty maneuvering in tight spaces, so Clark's fleet includes a special crane for this kind of work. It's a 40-Ton City Class mobile crane. They used it at Gibraltar because it not only fit into the building, but it had the proper boom configuration to reach up into the rafters to install the equipment. Clark is proud to brag a little about their varied fleet, because with it they can handle most any job that comes their way.
